Anyone selling goods or services door to door, from a vehicle, or from a temporary location in Kenyon needs this license after a police background check. Nonprofit and religious solicitations, farm produce sold by the grower, and sales to established customers are typically exempt; ask City Hall. Licensees must carry the license and show it on request.

Fee: \$125 investigation fee plus \$125 per day or \$500 per year.
